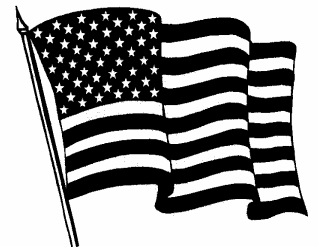

From the Secretary's Desk

Greetings,

There is an old song "June is busting out all over!" That is true here in Florida. Many of our Northern Neighbors have left. It is always sad to see them go. As we see their taillights we look forward to when we see their headlights.

As of this writing we have 620 active members. 543 have paid their dues for 2008 - 2009. There are still 77 that have not paid their dues. I have sent a letter to each of you. You are important to us. We need you. Wouldn't it be great to see the delinquent number at 0? With you help we can do it. I don't have the "Magic Number" from the state yet, but when I receive it, it will be posted in the Lodge.

We are off to a good start. In April we initiated 9 new members, had one dimit and reinstated two members.
