PROPOSAL TO CHANGE THE BY-LAWS OF PALMETTO LODGE # 2449 AS FOLLOWS (Vote will take place on March 8):

The amendment to ARTICLE IX: HOME, CLUB OR OTHER FACILITY

Section 1. (now reads)

The operation, management and control of the Home, Club or other facility owned and/or occupied by this Lodge shall be supervised and conducted by the Board of Directors of the Home (Club, etc) Corporation, incorporated under Section 16.030, of the Laws of the Order, consisting of seven members.

Section 1. (to be amended)

The operation, management and control of the Home, Club or other facility owned and/or occupied by this Lodge, incorporated under the provisions of Section 16.020, of the Laws of the Order, shall be managed, supervised and controlled by The Exalted Ruler, Esteemed Leading Knight, Esteemed Loyal Knight, Esteemed Lecturing Knight, and the five Trustees of the Lodge.

## **Leading Knights Corner**

The next time you get behind the wheel of your automobile, you can thank the Elks for:

- our modern day traffic laws
- traffic control devices
- roads designed to keep us safe.

From the first recorded traffic fatality in 1899 the annual toll continued to rise to 39,643 in 1937. Deeply concerned with the tragic aspects of automotive travel, the Order of Elks took the bold step of conducting a media blitz for thirteen continuous weeks. Safe driving messages were broadcast over a third of the nation's radio stations from November 1, 1937 through the holiday season. The campaign heightened public awareness, led to vastly improved laws and promoted safer road and automobile planning.

This wakeup call to the American public was immediately apparent as a 27 percent drop in fatalities over the preceding year was recorded. The Elks received praise from major newspapers and President Franklin Delano Roosevelt.

Having seen the need for change the Elks took decisive action. The next time you get behind the wheel and fasten your seat belt, remember that the Elks were thinking of your safety long before you were. Please drive safely. From Elks.org website/history, By Mike Kelly, Grand Lodge Historian


