In <u>Drugs: True Stories</u> (25-min) Joel describes his addiction to opioids. His parents and sister tell how his addiction - starting in 10th grade - devastated their family.

The accompanying discussion guide, written with leading addiction experts, offers questions to help you lead vital conversations - and encourage kids to think critically about their decisions.

We also recommend our <u>Words Can Work: When Talking About Drugs</u> (28pp) for youth and parents - an ideal companion to the DVD. The stories and expert insight keep the conversation going
